

**WHITEFORD TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES

**Call to Order:** Supervisor Walter Ruhl called the workshop to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:32 p.m. in the Whiteford Township Office. Present were Township Board Members Donald Sahloff, Tim Hill, Bernice Heidelberg, Angela Christensen, Walter Ruhl, Alex Drescher, Township Attorney, Dave Kubiske, Township Engineer, Kirra Werstein, Registered Sanitarian with Monroe County Department of Health and approximately 80 guests.

**Citizens Workshop Regarding Questions On Future Plans For Water and Sewer In Whiteford Township:** Supervisor Walter Ruhl opened the workshop with a brief history of the water problems in Whiteford Township dating back to the early 1900's, and the pressure from the State of Michigan and the County of Monroe to provide sewer and water to its residents. Walter then asked guests to identify themselves when asking questions or making a statement, to limit their time so everyone had an opportunity to speak, and that the panel would answer each questions to the best of their ability. Numerous residents addressed the panel with various questions concerning both the current water project and possible future water and sewer districts. The panel answered questions and will consider suggestions made by residents.
